# **OBITUARIES**

Jennie Maud Rice
Residents of Smiths Cove,
were shocked to learn on
Christmas Eve, of the sudden
passing of Miss Jennie Maud
Rice, a well known resident
of the village. Apparently in
her usual good health on Friday, Miss Rice had made her
Christmas purchases and discussed her plans for the holiday with friends. She suffered
a stroke on Saturday morning
and succumbed later in the
day.

Seventy one years of age, Miss Rice was the last surviving member of the family of the late Mr. and Mrs. Jonas Rice of Smith's Cove. She was a member of the Smith's Cove Baptist Church and was active in the work of Home Division, Sons of Temperance, and the Women's Institute of Smith's Funeral Service will be held from the Smith's Cord Baptist Church, Wednesday, at 2 p. m., conducted by the Rev. Francis Miller. Interment will be in the family lot.
