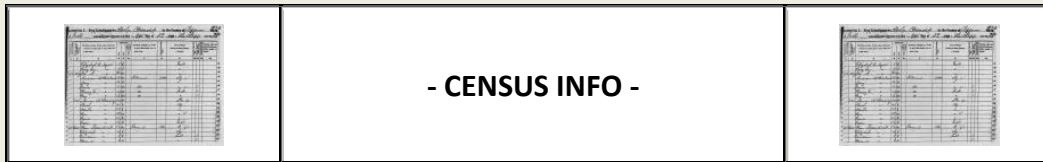

- TS Winchester possibly in NB in 1851 but 1851 census returns do not exist for Carleton (where they lived per newspaper marriage notice) and Portland Parish.
- TS Winchester’s son, George Smith, named his youngest son, George **Farrell** Winchester.

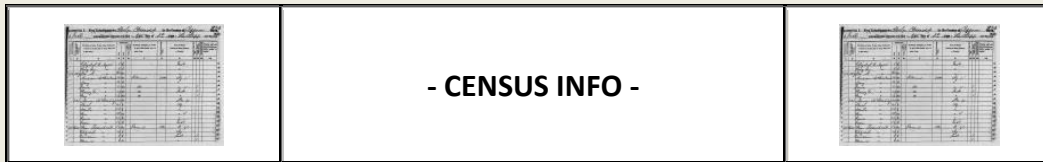

Notes:

- (Thomas) Smith Winchester d. 1881 at Togus, Maine.
- Son Charles Alonzo, b. 1867 *not* in HH; cannot locate on NS or US census.
- In 1855 Andrew P Smith (Age,6) is in the HH (Randolph, Mass.) of A L Cushing with Ann Smith (Age, 8)= *possibly* sister to Andrew; Andrew had a sister Lucy H > m. Orvis Writer; d. 1905, aged 55.
- In 1860 at Dorchester is Sarah Smith (Age, 34, b. NS) and Andrew P Smith, aged 10, b. Mass.
- In 1865 Andrew is living with his mother (widow) at Dorchester in HH of Abel Cushing (b. 1785; widower of Hannah Whiton)
- In 1870 Sarah and Andrew are living in Boston (Ward-4); Sarah's age noted as "14" [sic]

- Identity of Jennie M Teel and Relationship to Sarah A Smith -

- Jennie Teele/Teal m. William L **Beckwith** (ROM *not* located).
- Hannah (Margaret?)Hopkins & Sarah A Smith= (1) sisters (2) daughters of Joseph Hopkins = Marianna (—) (3) baptized on same day (11 July 1827) in Queen's Co., NS. (Source: "Queen's County Gen-Website: *Queens County Births from Primary Sources*".
- ROD (1904) notes: Age: 43. Born: Port Medway, NS; Parents: John Teele and Hannah Hopkins (b. Port Medway, NS).
- Mayflower ancestry back to Stephen Hopkins through his son Giles (NEHGR Vol. 105, p. 33).
